Message from the Headteacher,

New School Building Update: We are pleased to confirm that Officers at South Oxfordshire District Council are now happy with the detailed planning application for the Long Wittenham redevelopment sites that will provide a new primary school and village hall, in addition to the provision of 47 new homes. The officers' delegated report has been finalised and issued recommending approval to the application, subject to completion of a Section 106 agreement which will ensure the legal commitments to provide the new community buildings, as well as other necessary infrastructure. Solicitors for SODC, OCC and Thomas Homes have been instructed to finalise the details of the Section 106 obligations, which when signed and completed will allow SODC to issue the planning permission.

Year 6 Visit to Junior Citizenship: On Tuesday Year 6 students visited Junior Citizenship. During this outing, they learned invaluable lessons on how to stay safe in various everyday situations. We are proud to report that they represented our school with exemplary behaviour and enthusiasm. 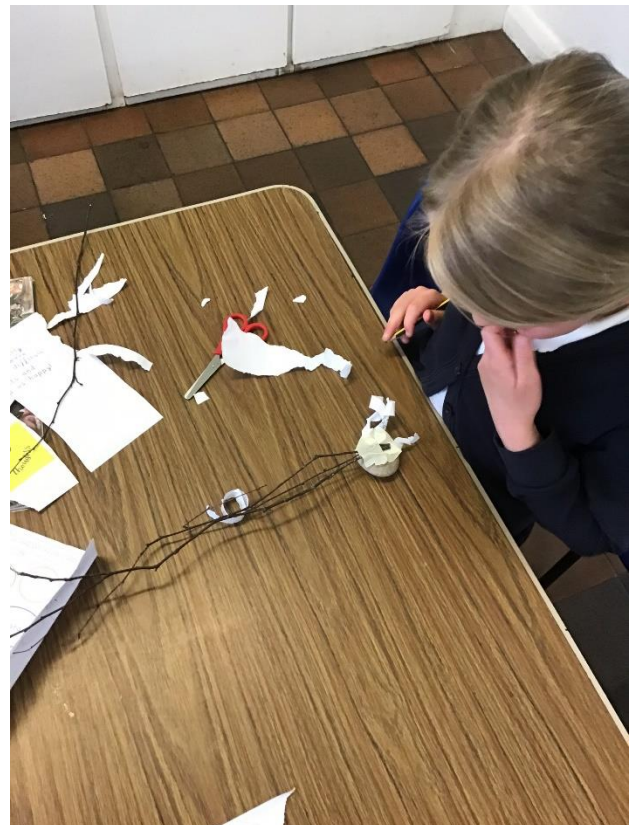
